Consent Agenda - Adoption of Safe Congregation Policy and Adoption of Kimberly Wootan's contract moved to discussion items. Peter moves to approve the revised consent agenda; motion passes.

Discussion (6:00-7:25)

- 1. Safe Congregation Policy was discussed. Poppy moves that we adopt the policy as it stands; Katy seconds, and the motion passes.
- 2. Kimberly Wootan's Contract for summer ministry was discussed. Peter moves to adopt the contract, Poppy seconds, and the motion passes.
- 3. Minister's and Op Team Report Rev. Dr. Morris
 - Two new groups are in formation and working on charters: an Accessibility group and a group called Challenging Racism Putting Love Into Action.
 - The operations team is debugging and devirusing the website and email systems which have been the target of an online attack.
 - Administry team reports the custodial team has been revitalized and Building and Grounds is making wonderful progress with small touches that make a big difference
 - The very successful annual appeal was coordinated by Rev. Dr. Morris. A programmatic model was used and the pledge secretary reports that 96 pledges have been received, 24 of which are new households. 82 households have yet to pledge.
- 4. Treasurer's Report Katy
 - After last month's announcement of the interest rate adjustment, we were expecting an increase of 400-500/month to our mortgage. Shortly after the February board meeting, Katy noticed an error in the bank documents, which is in

- our favor. Our previously negotiated contract mandates that our interest will not increase until 2021.
- Fundraising will be calendared with names attached to fundraising events for the next year to help accomplish reaching the yearly fundraising goal.
- 5. Developmental Minister Search Updates Barbara
 - We do not have ministerial candidates yet. UUA triages searches based on ministry (e.g., settled minister first, then developmental, and finally intern ministers). We are scheduled to meet with the Compensation Consultant, a UUA search requirement.
- 6. Annual Report Barbara
 - Barbara has reached out to all currently chartered groups and has requested reports be submitted to her by mid-May.
- 7. Board Task Force Updates:
 - a. Looking Forward report has been submitted online Peter
 - b. Covenantal Conversations report has been submitted online Peter
 - c. Quarterly Conversations Janell
 - Next event is March 18th and the agenda has been sent to board members and posted within the congregation.
 - o Annual meeting is June 10th
 - d. Bylaw review Bob
 - Team reviewed previous boards' work on bylaw review.
 - The current task force will consolidate the inherited document for readability.
 - There is a recommendation to review and analyze previous annual meetings and GA plenary sessions.
 - e. Earthquake Policy Bob
 - The board is asked to consider how the church will respond in the event of a massive earthquake. For example, how would the emergency be managed if it happened during sunday service? What could the church offer to the community during such an event? A community emergency planning group exists and there is a recommendation to connect a church representative with that group for future planning.
